Primary Election 2024 Update!

Primary Election Day: June 25th 2024

Early Voting: June 15th – 23rd 2024

Primary Elections are when candidates of the SAME party run against each other to determine who will be on the ballot in the General Election in November. Therefore, only currently enrolled members of that party can vote in that party's Primary Election.

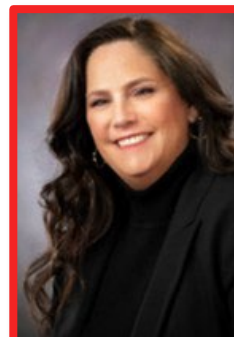
No Primary Election is held for a political party in an election district if all the races only have one candidate from that political party running for each position.

** ONLY Democrats have Primary Elections in 2024 **

So if you are a registered voter but not already enrolled in the Democratic Party you do NOT have a primary this year and you don't have to vote until the General Election on November 5th.

The last day to register a new voter for the 2024 Primary Election is June 15th.

Early Vote by Mail



Starting this year any voter can request an Early Voting Mail Ballot.

This works the same as an Absentee Ballot with two exceptions:

- 1) You do not need to be Sick, Disabled, or out of the County to request one – it's just another option for voting
- 2) You must submit a new request every year that you wish to use this method of voting

Like a traditional Absentee Ballot, you will **NOT** be able to vote on a voting machine for any election that you requested an Early Vote by Mail Ballot for (but you can vote in-person via Affidavit Ballot). The deadlines for requesting an Early Voter by Mail Ballot is June 15th.

Early Voting Sites: Primary Election 2024

Early Voting: June 15th – 23rd 2024

Polling Hours: Mon, Wed, Fri: 9am-5pm; Tues & Thurs 12-8pm; Sat-Sun: 9am-5pm

Due to the limited number of districts having a Primary Election in 2024, the Monroe County Board of Elections has reduced the number of Polling Locations accordingly, which includes less Early Voting Locations.

We will return to the standard number of Election Day and Early Voting Polling Sites for the 2024 General Election.
