Important Election Information

The Monroe County Board of Elections would like to ensure voters are prepared for the registration and mailed ballot application deadlines for the Democratic Primary to be held Tuesday, June 25, 2024, 6am-9pm.

New Registrant deadline – Received by June 15

Change of Address deadline – Received by June 10

Absentee/Early Mail Vote application deadline – Received by June 15

Absentee/Early Mail Vote ballot return deadline – Postmark by June 25

In-person Absentee/Early Mail Vote application deadline – June 24

REGISTRATION: Any voter can check their registration status at www.monroecounty.gov/etc/voter/. Eligible residents can register to vote at www.ny.gov/services/register-vote or send a registration card into the Board of Elections.

EARLY VOTING: Early voting commences June 15 – June 23. See times and locations at www.monroecounty.gov/elections-earlyvoting. Voters seeking to cast their vote by an early mail vote must request an application or submit electronically through the portal <https://ballotapplication.elections.ny.gov/home/earlymail>.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS: Voters who wish to cast their vote by an absentee ballot must request an application or submit electronically through the portal www.monroecounty.gov/elections-absentee.

POSTCARDS: Each year postcards are mailed to all eligible voters. Postcards include current polling sites and important information about voting options. If any changes occur to a polling site after the postcard has been sent, another letter will be mailed with the new information. Voters can check their polling site at www.monroecounty.gov/etc/voter/.
