County Clerk Jamie Romeo Announces Grand Opening of New Irondequoit DMV

(Rochester NY) – Monroe County Clerk Jamie Romeo is incredibly proud and excited to announce that as of this morning the new Irondequoit DMV is open to the public at its new location in Irondequoit Plaza at 525 Titus Avenue #A135.

County Clerk Jamie Romeo stated that *“When I became County Clerk, one of the first things that became clear to me was that we needed to update and modernize our oldest DMV branches. As DMV transactions become more complex, and with the REAL ID deadline coming in less than a year, it is vital that all Monroe County DMV branches are equipped to best serve the community. The new facility offers more space for customers and most importantly, provides long-needed upgrades to connectivity with New York State. Any move is difficult, but I want to thank my team at the Monroe County DMV for all their patience during this project, the County Legislature for funding this project, and our friends at State DMV for their help making this transition a success!”*

“Infrastructure isn’t just roads and bridges, it’s the facilities and equipment we need to more equitably serve the public,” **said County Executive Adam Bello.** *“Under Monroe County Clerk Jamie Romeo’s leadership, the new Irondequoit DMV office will provide outstanding customer service that keeps pace with the changing needs of the community.”*

All Monroe County DMV Branches are open Monday through Friday, 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM to both walk-ins and appointments. Appointments are required for any permit testing, including both learner’s permit and CDLs, along with applying for a REAL ID or Enhanced Driver’s License (EDL). Another Important Reminder: On May 7, 2025, all U.S. travelers must be REAL ID-compliant to board domestic flights and access certain federal facilities.
