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Monroe County Accepting Online Submissions for Large Gathering Event Notifications

The Monroe County Department of Public Health has opened <u>an online form</u> for non-residential, food service site operators to notify MCDPH of upcoming large gathering events, such as wedding receptions.

Per New York State guidance at this time, venues may host gatherings of up to 150 people or 50% capacity of the space, whichever is less. At least five days prior to each event, the site operators must provide MCDPH with details about the event using this online form.

Site operators must also attest to having reviewed all applicable New York State interim guidance for events during the COVID-19 public health emergency.

In addition, MCDPH is requiring venues to submit contact information for all attendees within 48 hours after each event.
