Monroe County Department of Public Health Warns of Potential Exposure to COVID-19 at Hamlin Hornets Banquet

The Monroe County Department of Public Health is alerting individuals who attended the Hamlin Hornets Banquet on Saturday, Nov. 27th, at Brockport Elks Lodge, 4400 Sweden Walker Rd in Brockport, of a possible exposure to COVID-19.

Several of the approximately 200 individuals in attendance Saturday between 6 p.m. and midnight have tested positive for COVID-19, and others may have come into close contact to these individuals.

Attendees experiencing COVID-like symptoms, regardless of vaccination status, and all unvaccinated attendees should immediately self-quarantine and contact MCDPH at (585)753-5555.

In general, the Monroe County Department of Public Health does not comment on potential or confirmed cases of COVID-19 concerning specific individuals, businesses or institutions unless doing so is necessary to prevent or lessen a serious and imminent threat to public health.
