STATEMENT FROM MONROE COUNTY EXECUTIVE ADAM BELLO ON GOV. KATHY HOCHUL'S PROPOSED NYS BUDGET

(Rochester, New York) – During her Fiscal Year 2023 Executive Budget presentation today, Gov. Kathy Hochul outlined her bold, clear vision for achieving a prosperous New Era for New York and Monroe County. Her strategic, fiscally responsible and forward-thinking plan makes key investments in our roads, bridges and other infrastructure as well as our pandemic recovery efforts, while giving middle-class taxpayers and homeowners welcome tax relief. She is addressing the climate crisis with urgency, recognizes the need to create and preserve affordable housing for struggling individuals and families and is helping COVID-19 affected businesses recover and rebuild.
