COUNTY EXECUTIVE BELLO ANNOUNCES 2024 A.P. PROPERTY SERVICES ROCHESTER INTERNATIONAL AIRSHOW LINEUP

Italian National Jet team Freccie Tricolori headline the event sponsored by A.P. Property Services; Monroe County War on Terror Memorial named charitable benefit recipient

ROCHESTER, NY — Monroe County Executive Adam Bello and the Frederick Douglass Greater Rochester International Airport today announced the official lineup for the 2024 A.P. Property Services Rochester International Airshow. The popular community event will return to the Rochester skies the weekend of Saturday, August 3 and Sunday, August 4, 2024, and will feature the Italian Air Force National Jet team Freccie Tricolori, the CAF RISE ABOVE Squadron, and other exciting aerial performers and static displays. The Monroe County War on Terror Memorial will be the charitable beneficiary of this year's airshow.

"Whether you come for the high-flying aerobatic performances like the Freccie Tricolori and the F-16 Viper demo, or the educational and inspiring CAF RISE ABOVE program, the 2024 A.P. Property Services Rochester International Airshow has something for everybody," said Monroe County Executive Adam Bello. "We are grateful to Sean Fico and his team at A.P. Property Services for their support of this year's airshow, and look forward to welcoming spectators from throughout our community to the Frederick Douglass Greater Rochester International Airport for this can't miss event."

The ROC Airshow is one of only six American show sites for Freccie Tricolori, which is performing in the United States for the first time since 1992. Freccie Tricolori was founded on March 1, 1961 and currently operates the Aermacchi MB-339-A/PAN, a two-seat fighter-trainer aircraft. Made up of 10 aircraft – nine in formation and one soloist – Freccie Tricolori are the world's largest acrobatic team. One of the highlights of their performance is their signature red, white, and green smoke.

The CAF RISE ABOVE Squadron, a three-fold educational outreach program that brings the history and legacy of the Tuskegee Airmen and Women Airforce Service Pilots (WASP) to life. The CAF RISE ABOVE program includes:

- The RISE ABOVE Traveling exhibit – a 53' mobile theater featuring two original short films that tell the story of the Tuskegee Airmen and the WASP.
- P-51C Mustang – a fully restored World War II-era P-51C Mustang, the signature aircraft of the Tuskegee Airmen and an AT-6 Texan Nella
- Other extensive educational resources for anyone looking to learn more about these remarkable American trailblazers.
